FOH is a non-profit organization working with referral agencies to identify families in need of gently used, donated furniture and household necessities. #### Art Submission

#### PLEASE READ CAREFULLY:

- 1) Complete the Entry Form. Entry forms may be submitted with art when dropped off or by visiting www.focusonhome.org website. Art will need to be dropped off (by appointment only). Contact: Joli Sanders 405-620-6055 or Tish 405-323-8327.
- 2) Contestants' name, grade, and school MUST be written carefully on the back side of the artwork. Include the title as well. *This step is important, as your entry form will be separated from your artwork.*
- 3) Your Entry Form should NOT be attached to the artwork. No tape, no staples, no glue, no paper clips!
- 4) Entries will NOT be returned to the contestant: FOCUS ON HOME plans to display the artwork at the Oklahoma State Capitol and selected art will be auctioned to benefit families assisted by FOCUS ON HOME. The remainder of the art will be used to help transform the home environments of families.
- 5) Give your artwork a creative title.
- 6) All artwork entered in the contest can be any length & width but must not exceed 4 inches in depth. Acceptable mediums include: Paintings (including oil, acrylics, and watercolor), Drawings (including pastels, colored pencil, pencil, charcoal, ink, and markers. It is recommended that charcoal and pastel drawings be fixed.), Collages (must not exceed 4inches), Prints (including lithographs, silkscreen, and block prints), Mixed Media (use of more than two mediums such as pencil, ink, watercolor, etc.), Computer-generated art (must be printed), & Photography.
- 7) All entries must be original in concept, design and execution and may not violate any U.S. copyright laws. Any entry that has been copied from an existing photo or image (including a painting, graphic, or advertisement) that was created by someone other than the student is a violation of the competition rules and will not be accepted. Work entered must be in the original medium (with the exception of digital media).

#### ART CONTEST RULES:

- 1) Submitted artwork must be your original creation.
- 2) No tracing of others' artwork.

- 8) The Art Contest will be judged by a panel of judges appointed by FOCUS ON HOME.
